



2010 SLE Mutton Bustin' Rules & Format
FRIDAY NIGHT RODEO – March 12, 2010

- I. Competition will be open to all youth during the Friday night rodeo performance given that they are between 4 & 7 years of age and weigh less than 60 pounds.
- II. Those wishing to compete will meet on the bottom floor of the coliseum underneath sections G & H at the instruction of the rodeo announcer during the Friday night rodeo performance.
- III. All potential contestants will draw to select the 8 riders that will participate in the Mutton Bustin' event.
- IV. Helmets and vests for contestants will be provided by [Justalil' Rodeo Company](#). Contestants should supply their own mouth piece. Mouth pieces will be available for purchase at the [Little Boots Rodeo](#) booth in the Garrett Coliseum.
- V. Members of the SLE Spectator Activities Committee will assist the 8 contestants in moving through the coliseum and being mounted atop sheep inside the bucking chutes.



2010 SLE Calf Scramble Rules & Format
SATURDAY AFTERNOON RODEO – March 13, 2010

- I. Competition will be open to all youth ages 12 and under during the Saturday afternoon rodeo performance.
- II. Those wishing to compete will meet on the bottom floor of the coliseum underneath sections G & H at the instruction of the rodeo announcer during the Saturday afternoon rodeo performance.
- III. All contestants will be ushered into the arena by SLE Spectator Activities Committee members and lined up across the width of the arena.
- IV. At the instruction of the rodeo announcer, a group of calves will be released from the roping pens. A few of these calves will have ribbons tied to their tails. Once all the calves are loose in the arena, the contestants will be signaled to begin the contest.
- V. Each contestant that delivers a ribbon to one of the SLE Spectator Activities Committee members will be awarded an envelope containing a cash prize of \$25.
